

St. Patrick's Day Facts

As long as you celebrate safely, St. Patrick's Day can be fun for all. Here are a few facts about the Irish holiday:

- St. Patrick's Day celebrates the traditional religious feast day of St.
 Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland.
- The first St. Patrick's Day parade took place not in Ireland, but the United States on March 17, 1737, in Boston.
- More than 100 St. Patrick's Day parades are held across the United States. New York City and Boston host the largest.
- There are roughly 35 million U.S. residents with Irish ancestry, more than seven times the population of Ireland itself.
- There are approximately 144,588 current U.S. residents who were born in Ireland**.
- You may hear some phrases in Gaelic/Irish on St. Patrick's Day. The most common: Erin health/cheers.

Shamrocks, saint and shillelaghs

St. Patrick's Day, celebrated on March 17, honors Ireland's patron saint who died on that day in 461. Icons of the Irish holiday and the history of St. Patrick:

Shamrock

Irish flag

Small, three-leafed herb appears on United Kingdom's coat of arms with English rose, Scottish thistle Green stands for Catholics; orange for Protestants; white for wish for harmony

Leprechauns

Fairies who work day and night mending shoes of other fairies Shillelagh (shi-lay'-lee) Walking stick; word is

Irish for stout oak club or cudgel; also name of a forest that once stood in County Wicklow

Patrick: Saint and legend

387: Born in Britain to a Roman family; his father served as a magistrate; his original name was Maewyn Early 400s: Taken to Ireland as a slave; after six years, he escaped to France where he studied for priesthood

432: Sent to Ireland as a Christian missionary by Pope Celestine I, who named him Patricius, which means noble in Latin; he introduced Roman alphabet, Latin literature; Christianized land






St. Patrick's Cathedral in Dublin, Ireland



CONQUERING SETBACKS, CELEBRATING SUCCESS.

Approved Project Hope participants enter into a 1 year contract to receive Intensive case management services to enhance life skills, achieve and maintain their housing, build social skills and community relationships and to address their individual needs with the goal of becoming self-sufficient.



Working in close partnership with the Cheyenne VA Medical Center, our Veteran Housing Services provides short-term housing for homeless veterans as they work with case managers to secure permanent housing.

Crossroads Healthcare Clinic provides primary medical care, mental health services and substance abuse services to individuals and families who are currently homeless and a small percentage of low-income persons who are currently housed.
