Fourth of July Firework Safety-Have Fun-Stay safe!!!

- 1. Do not disassemble pre-assembled fireworks, attempt to make your own fireworks, or combine firework products.
- 2. Make sure your fireworks are stored correctly and according to the packaged instructions.
- 3. Only light fireworks on flat ground, away from flammable materials, and only in a dry and fire-resistant area.
- 4. Do not light multiple fireworks at the same time.
- 5. Ensure the person lighting the fireworks is equipped with safety glasses and keep all spectators at a safe distance.
- 6. Do not allow young children to handle or light fireworks. Always have an adult supervise fireworks activities.
- 7. Keep a fire extinguisher nearby, along with a hose or bucket in case of a fire or malfunction.

If a firework malfunctions, do not relight it. Instead, soak it in water and dis-

Ground Beef Zucchini Noodles

Main course - Prep time 10 min - Cook time 15 min - Serves 4

2 Medium Zucchini 1 tbsp Anchovy Paste

1 lb Ground Beef 2 Bouillon cubes

1/2 Chopped red bell Pepper 1 tsp thyme

1/2 Chopped Onion 1/2 tsp salt

1 tbsp Cayenne pepper

Spiralize your zucchini or slice into thin noodles. Brown ground beef. Added peppers, onions, and spices. After 5 mins add zucchini noodles. Cook 5-10 minute till zucchini reaches desired texture.




Working in close partnership with the Cheyenne VA Medical Center, our <u>Veteran Housing Services</u> provides short-term housing for homeless veterans as they work with case managers to secure permanent housing.
